

Trailer Race Rules

1st Place: \$250 | 2nd Place: \$125 | 3rd Place: \$75

- The towing vehicle must only be a passenger car, minivan or small 2-wheel drive truck with no extra reinforcement allowed.
 - All glass, except the front windshield, must be removed.
 - All doors must be latched/fastened shut. Optional - Drivers door may be covered on the outside with a minimum 1/8" thick steel plate that encompasses the "A" and "B" pillars. Plate must be a minimum of 12" in height.
 - Light duty trailers only. Trailer must have been street legal at one time. No converted pickup box trailers. Pop-up campers are allowed.
 - The object is to separate the trailer from a vehicle or complete the scheduled laps first. After your trailer has been removed or if the vehicle is excessively damaged and/or dragging parts, you will be black flagged out of the event. Ignoring the black flag will result in immediate ceasing of racing.
 - Track officials have final say on vehicle eligibility.

MINI-VAN DEMO DERBY RULES

1st Place: \$500 | 2nd Place: \$250 | 3rd Place: \$100

- The mini van demo derby is open to men and women who have a valid drivers license and are 18 years of age; if 16 or 17 years of age you must have a notarized consent from parent or guardian. In the interest of fairness to all contestants the following rules and regulations shall prevail.
1. Vans shall be mini vans, no full size vans and no full frame or flat nose vans.
 2. Driver and pit persons must sign waiver and release of liability prior to entering pit area or arena.
 3. Drivers must attend drivers meeting prior to race.

Participant regulations

- This is a stand-alone event. Drivers have one minute to hit another active van. *No sandbagging and NO team driving. NO intentional driver door hits.*

All glass, chrome, pot metal, lights, carpet, seats and headliner must be removed before reaching the exhibit area. Windsheild optional.

Slogans or advertising may be put anywhere but on the drivers door. Numbers to be placed on both sides and roof.

Radiators and fans may be removed but not relocated.

Batteries must be placed in a secure position. They must not move when shaken and must be covered with something non-flammable.

Bumpers and fenders may be trimmed. No full size or truck bumpers allowed.

Doors may be welded solid. Back van door weld 1 inch leave 6 inches or wire or bolt.

Cages can go to the middle of the vans side door. Cannot be hooked to the frame. A total of 3 bars going across allowed. One in dash area, one behind seat and one in the middle of the side door.

If windsheild removed must have at least one bar attached to middle of the windshield area to prevent hood from coming in. This may be welded on.

Hoods must be wired, chained shut, or if bolts are used you may use a maximum of 6 (six) 3/8 with washers no bigger than 6 inches outside diameter. NONE to frame or in front of radiator.

4-ply tires only. NO water in tires, NO tires screwed to rims, NO tire inside of tire.

NO extra weight, NO trailer hitches, NO special lifts, blocks, shackles. Airlifts and air shocks must be deflated.

Safety belt and DOT approved helmet required. Long pants and shirt mandatory.

Do not do anything other than what is stated in these rules. This is a stock class. No pit persons allowed in the arena. NO alcoholic beverages or drugs allowed. If any changes are made after inspection to make your van illegal you will be disqualified.

MANDATORY OPEN HOOD INSPECTION DO NOT WIRE YOUR HOOD BEFORE YOU GET THERE OR YOU WILL BE CUTTING THIS OFF.

Roll-Over Rules

1st Place: \$400 | 2nd Place: \$200 | 3rd Place \$100

- Recommended smaller cars (front & rear wheel drive ok) and pickups (i.e. S-10). No buses, motorhomes or farm trucks. All entries will be inspected for safety items.
- Roll Cage: Must have at least a two-post roll cage installed. Four-point highly recommended. Must be securely braces and fastened to frame or unibody. No roll bars outside the cars. Doors must be chained or welded shut. Air bags must be removed. Use stock gas tanks. No tanks inside the vehicle driver/passenger compartment.
- Glass: All Glass must be removed. Screen is permitted in front windshield area. All glass and debris must be vacuumed from cars. All flammable material inside the car must be removed (upholstery, carpets, mats, headliners, etc.)
- Safety Equipment: Window net mandatory. Helmet: Snell 1995 or newer mandatory. Full-face helmet recommended. Eye protection (goggles, safety glasses) required. Minimum 4-point racing harness system is required. Fire-retardant driver uniform required.
- Participants will be allowed two rolls. Best score of two is taken.
